

	<b>PROMOTIONAL VISITS</b>	<b>POLICY</b>  Approved for Publication
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For the background information relating to this policy, refer to N-02100-PL0679.

- 1 When OHS Inspectors visit vessels or structures that are potential facilities, they must obtain evidence that consent has been given by the operator of the proposed facility.
- 2 OHS Inspectors wishing to undertake a promotional visit must also liaise with the safety regulator responsible for the proposed facility and any other MoU partner or relevant authority, such as a port authority, if the vessel or structure is in port.
- 3 OHS Inspectors must make it clear to the operator of the proposed facility the differences between a promotional visit and an inspection, and make it clear that NOPSA cannot exercise their powers during the visit.
- 4 Where applicable, OHS Inspectors will write to the operator of the proposed facility following the visit with a list of observations for improving occupational health and safety performance, and advice on the legislative regime.
- 5 It is NOPSA's policy to not undertake visits to potential facilities located in foreign countries. Any variation of this policy requires the written permission of NOPSA's Chief Executive Officer.
